- ▀ This “state of the art” program is directed by a team of experienced wound care nurses that includes a Certified Wound, Ostomy, Continence Nurse (CWOCN) as well as a Wound Care Certified Nurse.
- ▀ We have digital imaging that is available and used throughout the company to enhance physician-nurse communication and promote care coordination. Pictures may be emailed or delivered to physicians upon request.
- ▀ Our wound care practice is research and evidence based.
- ▀ Each office is staffed with Registered Nurses that have advanced knowledge and training in the prevention, detection, and treatment of complex wounds.
- ▀ Negative Pressure Wound Therapy is available to promote wound healing and decrease healing times.
- ▀ In-home sharps debridement by CWOCN can be performed upon physician’s request.
- ▀ Anodyne Therapy is available to treat the symptoms of diabetic neuropathy as well as promote circulation in lower extremity wounds.
- ▀ AHH has nurses experienced in the application of compression wraps for the treatment of stasis ulcers and the management of lymphadema.
- ▀ Bed-side Doppler studies are available upon physician’s request.
- ▀ Standardized patient education is used to ensure consistent and comprehensive education to allow the patient/caregiver to assist with and promote patient well-being.
